

General Information

The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS®) developed by ATI testing is a standardized test that provides objective measurement of an individual's specific ability with content areas that measure entry-level academic readiness of health science program applicants. The ATI TEAS®, *Version 7* is the newest version of the exam and evaluates performance within the indicated areas.

COMPONENTS OF THE ATI TEAS®

- Reading
- Mathematics
- Science
- English and Language Usage

What score do I need to make?

The admission requirements for the Baton Rouge General School of Nursing specify a minimum of 65% Total Score for ATI TEAS® exam. ATI TEAS® total score will not be rounded.

What if I have already taken the TEAS®, Version 7 and want to use that score?

You will need to have your official TEAS transcript sent directly to the Baton Rouge General School of Nursing from ATI. You can purchase a TEAS Transcript either from your ATI student account or the ATI's Online Store for a fee charged by ATI. TEAS 6th edition scores will be accepted through May 15th, 2023.

Can I take the TEAS® more than one time?

Prospective students may take the TEAS® exam a total of three times within a year at 14 to 30-day interval to allow appropriate remediation.

How do I register to take the TEAS®?

1st Option: A remote version of the ATI TEAS® Exam with Proctorio will be offered by the Baton Rouge General School of Nursing on the following dates: October 14th beginning at 9am and October 20th beginning at Noon.

Prospective students will need to contact the school directly *at least 3 working days prior to testing date* to schedule and will be required to pay the testing fee of \$115.

Additional information will be provided regarding technical requirements needed for remote testing with Proctorio.

How can I prepare for the test?

The TEAS® Study Manual and practice tests are available for purchase on the ATI website at www.atitesting.com along with a TEAS® Study Package that combines the manual and practice tests at a discounted price. These study materials can be located by clicking on the online store and then shop by TEAS products.

2nd Option:

The TEAS® can also be scheduled at a testing site by following the instructions below.

1. *Access ATI testing on the internet at www.atitesting.com. Create an account with ATI using the instructions provided on the website. Note: If you already have an account with ATI, simply login to your account.*
2. *Go to the Online Store, click TEAS, Register and select In-Person. For program type select TEAS for Nursing Students and search by PSI Testing Center.*
3. *You will need to click on the **www.psiexams.com** link for test site and time availability prior to registration. From the PSI Exams Online Home page, you will scroll to the bottom of the page and select the “click here” under check available appointment dates before you register.
 - a. *For Select organization: Certification/Professional Associations*
 - b. *Select sponsor name: ATI TEAS®*
 - c. *Select to find a test center, click here.*
 - d. *For Delivery mode, select Test Center and continue**
4. *Enter the zip or city into the space provided and click search. This will open a list of available test centers. Choose one or more from the available test centers. You will now be able to view available sessions for the date and month range shown. You will not be able to schedule TEAS® with PSI until you first make your purchase on the ATI website.*
5. *After you have completed registration and paid your registration fee on the ATI website, you will receive a receipt/confirmation email from ATI. This email contains the ID # required by PSI to complete your scheduling of the test. You will not be able to schedule an exam with PSI unless you first make your purchase on the ATI website. After scheduling the TEAS® with PSI, you will receive an email confirmation with the test center location and directions.*

Please note you will need to indicate during registration that you would like your scores to be sent to the Baton Rouge General Medical Center from the list of available institutions. By making this selection, your scores will automatically be sent to the School of Nursing upon completion of the test.
