## <u>Title IV Funding Notice for Program's Disclosure of Meeting Minimum State Licensure and National Certification Requirements:</u>

Any student participating in the Professional Program of the Baton Rouge General School of Radiologic Technology will meet the minimum requirements for their state's licensure and national certification. The following notice and chart are verified by the program annually and the program's accreditor (JRCERT). The information is available to all students via the website under the "Admissions" tab, located here in the program's official interest brochure, and submitted both electronically and in writing to students within their acceptance letter into the program, and electronically and in writing during both Junior and Senior year Spring semesters.

Consistent with revised United States Department of Education (USDE) regulations, the USDE requires that programs that participate in Title IV federal funding must disclose if the programs' educational requirements meet the states' professional licensure or certification requirements. JRCERT records identify the radiography program sponsored by Baton Rouge General Medical Center as participating in Title IV federal funding and the JRCERT serves as the program's gatekeeper. There are two types of disclosure required by the USDE.

General Disclosure requires posting information that includes state by state determination that the program fulfills educational requirements for licensure or certification in that state. The information on the Chart and the program's website has been verified by the JRCERT and the program as of 1/13/2022. (Reviewed Annually for Continued Compliance)

The requirement for Direct Disclosure communications will be to individual students who are enrolled in or are considering enrolling in a program that will lead to licensure or certification. The Direct Disclosure must indicate whether the student's chosen program (Baton Rouge General School of Radiologic Technology) does in fact fulfill the educational requirements for state licensure or certification within the student's state of residence as presented on 1/13/2022 (Reviewed Annually for Continued Compliance). The USDE requires that this disclosure be in writing and may be provided electronically. BRG SORT accomplishes this annually in the student's acceptance letter acknowledging that as of the date of the acceptance letter the program fulfills the educational requirements for state licensure or certification within the student's state of residence; the statement posted to the admissions section of the website; in the Program's Brochure - in print at the office, emailed, or posted to the website; and emailed and printed in letter form to the current students of BRG SORT.
