- All exhibiting artists must submit an artist statement and resume or curriculum vitae to BRG AIM for informational purposes. The artist must also submit an inventory list of all art that will be included in the exhibit. Said inventory list (images included), signed by the artist, must be attached to this agreement, and thereby made part of the same.
- Baton Rouge General Medical Center, Arts in Medicine, et al and their agents or assigns shall be held harmless for any loss, theft, or damage that may occur to art works during installation or while in possession, supervision, or auspices of the BRG Café Gallery, its agreed representatives, or employees. Baton Rouge General policy requires that in-house maintenance and facilities personnel hang and remove all artwork using a locking system. BRG and AIM will take every precaution with the installation.
- Insurance is the sole responsibility of the lender artist, and if lost, stolen, or damaged, neither Baton Rouge General nor the Arts in Medicine Program will be held responsible. This includes any storage, and/or removal of all exhibition components from the venue. Packing of all artwork is the responsibility of the artist.
- BRG and AIM shall review all work before it is exhibited in the aforesaid spaces and hereby reserve the right to exclude the artwork(s) from the exhibition.

- Exhibited artwork shall not be removed from the BRG Café Gallery during the exhibition by artist(s) or any representative of the artist(s). Unless agreed upon in advance, all artwork/exhibits should be removed at the close of the exhibition. If the artist(s) does not remove artwork on the final day of the exhibition, BRG AIM will remove pieces. Labor and storage fees will be assessed. When the art is returned, BRG AIM will sign the release form at the bottom of this agreement.
- Unless notified in writing, in advance, it is understood and agreed that artwork(s) may be photographed or electronically recorded for archival and/or promotional purposes without compensation and in perpetuity.
- All sales of artwork(s) will be based on information given by the artist. If art pieces are not for sale, please notify Arts in Medicine. Unless agreed upon in advance, BRG AIM will collect a 30% commission on sale of work. Art that is sold may be released to the purchaser on the day of sale, and the artist will be notified of the sale and monies rendered at the end of that month (per the instructions of the café bookkeeper). We will request a replacement piece in the style indicated in the first call or move to the next piece on the waiting list.
- Exhibited artwork will only be released to the artist personally or to a duly appointed (via written request) representative.
- Should Baton Rouge General exhibit spaces in facility be damaged in any way in the load-in or load-out of said exhibit, the exhibiting artist shall be responsible for payment of all repairs at facility.
