The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS®) developed by ATI testing is a standardized test that provides objective measurement of an individual's specific ability with content areas that measure entry-level academic readiness of health science program applicants. The ATI TEAS®, *Version 7* is the newest version of the exam and evaluates performance within the indicated areas.

- Science
- English and Language Usage

#### **What score do I need to make?**

*Baton Rouge General School of Nursing requires a minimum ATI TEAS® total score of **65%** for admission. ATI TEAS® total score **is not rounded up**.*

#### **How can I prepare for the test?**

*TEAS® preparation products are available for purchase on the ATI website at [www.atitesting.com](http://www.atitesting.com). These study materials can be located on the home page of ATI by clicking on the "TEAS" tab and then clicking on "Prep for TEAS" tab.*

#### **What if I have already taken the TEAS®, *Version 7* and want to use that score?**

*You will need to have your official TEAS transcript sent directly to the Baton Rouge General School of Nursing from ATI. You can purchase a TEAS Transcript for a fee charged by ATI by either 1) logging into your ATI student account, click RESULTS tab to view your scored TEAS exam and then click SEND TRANSCRIPT, or 2) by going to the ATI home page. click on the TEAS tab and then select TEAS Transcript.*

#### **Can I take the TEAS® more than one time?**

*Prospective students may take the TEAS® exam a total of three times within a 6-month period at 14 to 30-day interval to allow appropriate remediation between attempts.*
